



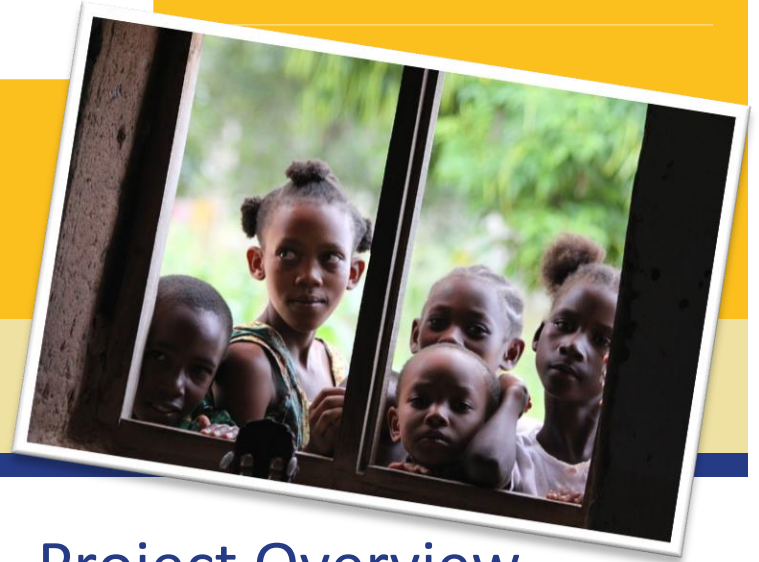

Project Overview

The Daniel Society's Rural HIV/AIDS Children's Initiative is our first global health project designed to promote the health and well-being of children living with HIV/AIDS. Sadly, **less than 50% of children with HIV/AIDS in Zambia are on lifesaving treatment.** For children living in rural villages in the Western Province, the problem is even more severe.

Once launched, our project will ensure that children receive treatment, ongoing health monitoring, and health education that promotes hope and health responsibility. Through collaboration with local leaders and organizations, the project will train field workers to perform health assessments, treatment monitoring, health workshops and serve as liaisons between villagers and the project's steering committee.
